Grand Island East Channel Light



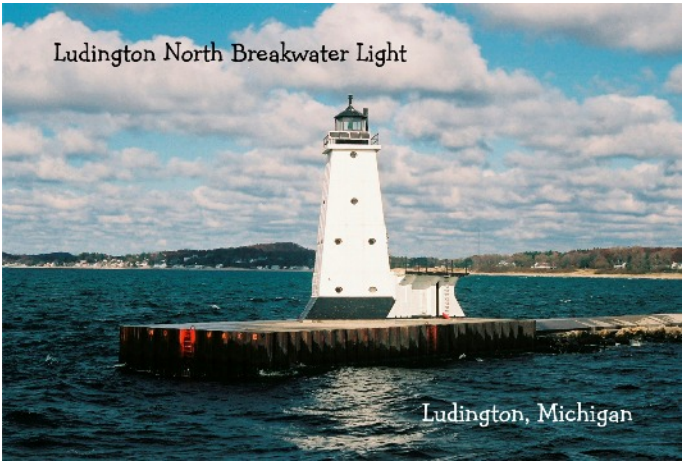
Before restoration in 2004.

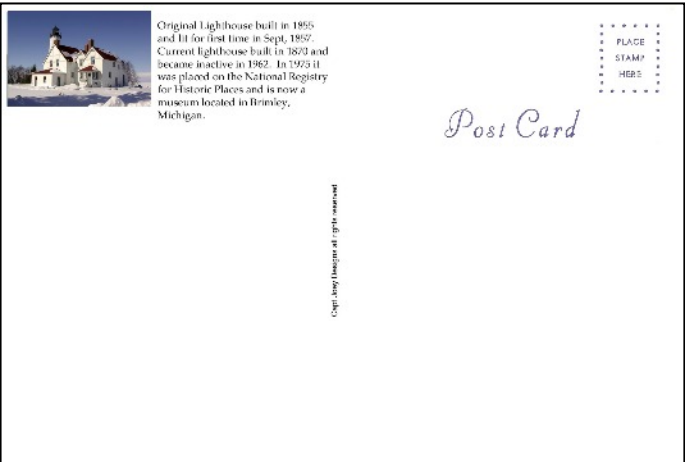
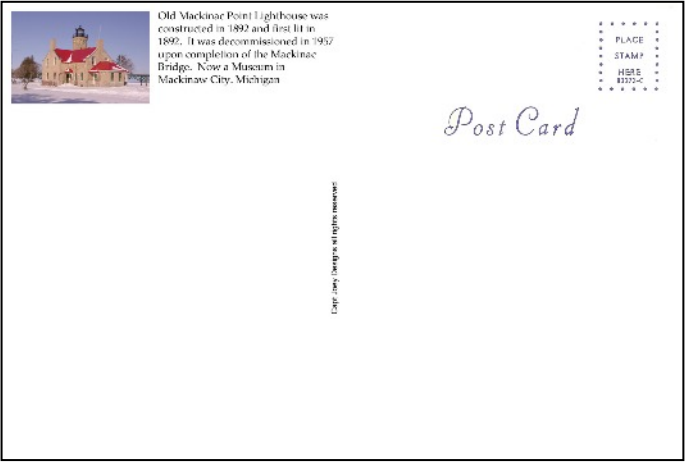
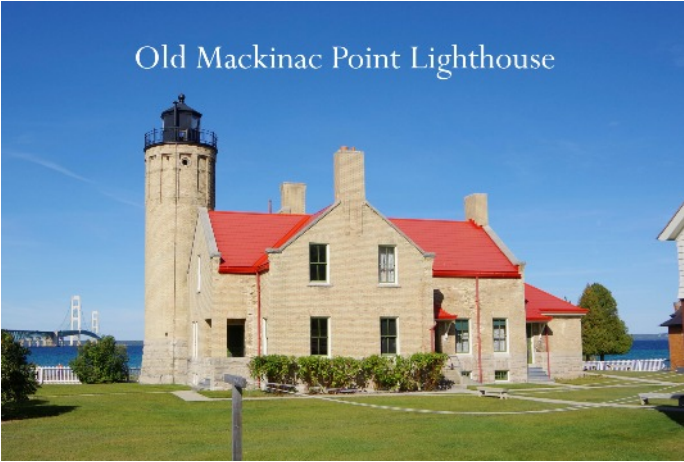
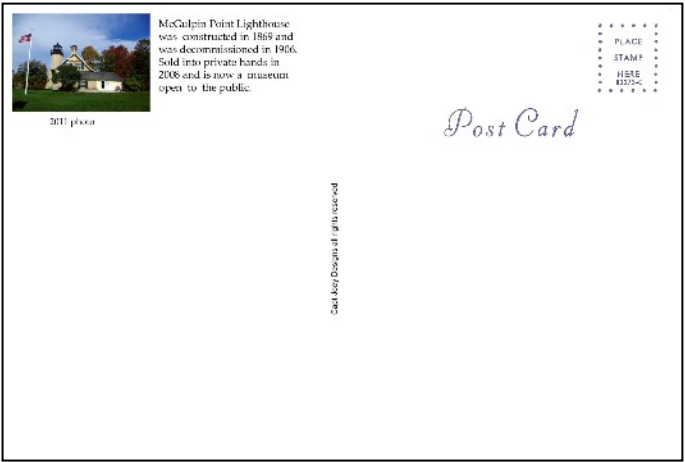
Originally built in 1853 as a wooden structure. Rebuilt as a brick structure in 1866. The second story of the building was added in 1896 and the light tower stands 20 feet high. The corner of the lens was a Loran Optic lens was placed in the lighthouse in the 1940's. A light keeper resided in the station from 1853 until 1865. The light is operated by the Coast Guard and the building & grounds by the Marquette Maritime Museum.

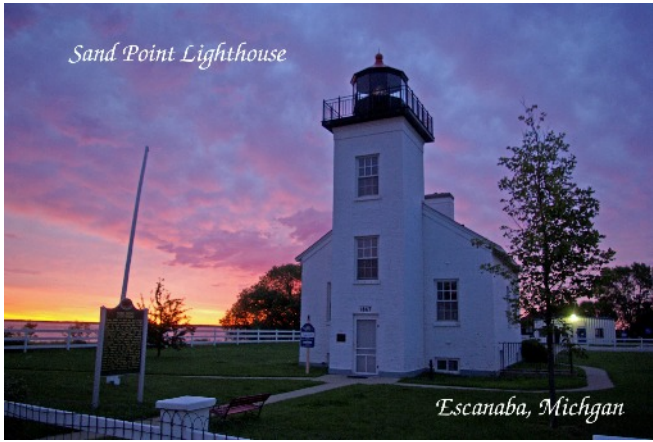
